- INVITATION

The Council of Seville acting as host, the Spanish Orienteering Federation (FEDO), the Andalusian Orienteering Federation and the ADOL Club as organisers, have pleasure in inviting all orienteerers to participate in the International Orienteering Meeting “Sevilla 2006 Juegos Mundiales.”

- GENERAL INFORMATION

The International Orienteering Meeting “Sevilla 2006 Juegos Mundiales” is a meeting over two days, for orienteerers on foot, during which the three following competitions will take place:

- Sprint: In the historic quarter of Seville, an open event in which all runners who have registered for the Meeting can participate and who have specifically registered by completing the form.
- Middle Distance: Points awarded for the ranking of the National Portuguese League, Spanish National and Andalusian Regional.
- Long Distance: Points awarded for the ranking of the National Portuguese League, Spanish National and Andalusian Regional, as well as for the International Orienteering Federation for the H/D 21E (W.R.E) categories.

- COMPETITION LOCATION

- Sprint: Seville capital

- Middle and Long Distance races: El Esparragal, approximately 25km from the centre of Seville

The Competition Centre will be located throughout the competition in Seville capital, in the competition zones.

- DATES

September 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th 2006

PROGRAMME

- Morning: Middle distance race (El Esparragal)
- Afternoon: Sprint race (historic quarter Seville)

* Sunday 10 September

- Morning: Long distance race (El Esparragal)
- Prize giving and closing ceremony

MAPS, TERRAIN AND SCALES

New maps, drawn in April 2006, according to the rules of the I.O.F.

Base Map: CARTOMAYA

Terrain

- Medium: Mediterranean forest with moderate slopes, very varied, with fences, agricultural land and some scrubland
- Long: coppice (Dehesa) of cork and oak with very gentle contours, clean and very fast terrain.
- Sprint: Historic quarter of Seville

Map scales:

- Long distance race: Scale 1:10,000 for all categories, apart from H/D 18A-20A-21A-21E-35 which will use 1:15,000
- Medium distance race: Scale 1:10,000 for categories
- Sprint race: Scale 1:5,000 for all categories

Races and Categories

- Medium and long distance
H/D 12-14-16-(18/20/21) B-18A-20A-21A-21E-35-40-45-50-55
Children's Initiation, Adults Initiation, Open and Correlín (infants).
- Sprint: The runners who wish to participate in the Sprint will need to enrol expressly through the Registration Bulletin. The Organisation will place the

participants within their categories in the following groups in order to determine classification and trophies.

Cadets (H/D born 1989 and after)
Junior (H/D born 1986, 1987 or 1988)
Senior (H/D no age limit)
Veterans A (H/D born between 1962 and 1971, both inclusive) and
Veterans B (H/D born 1961 or before)

LICENCES

For all categories, with the exception of Correlín (infants), it is necessary to be in possession of the corresponding Federation Licence, without which you will not be permitted to register. Those who do not have the Federation Licence and wish to participate, will need to indicate this and buy a subscription, as well as the “Licencia de Prueba” which will allow them to participate exclusively in the competitions of the Meeting and whose prices are 10 € for the Official categories and 4 € for the non Official categories (children’s Initiation, adults Initiation and Open)

*Prizes for the 3 first runners of every category, adding the Middle and Long races.

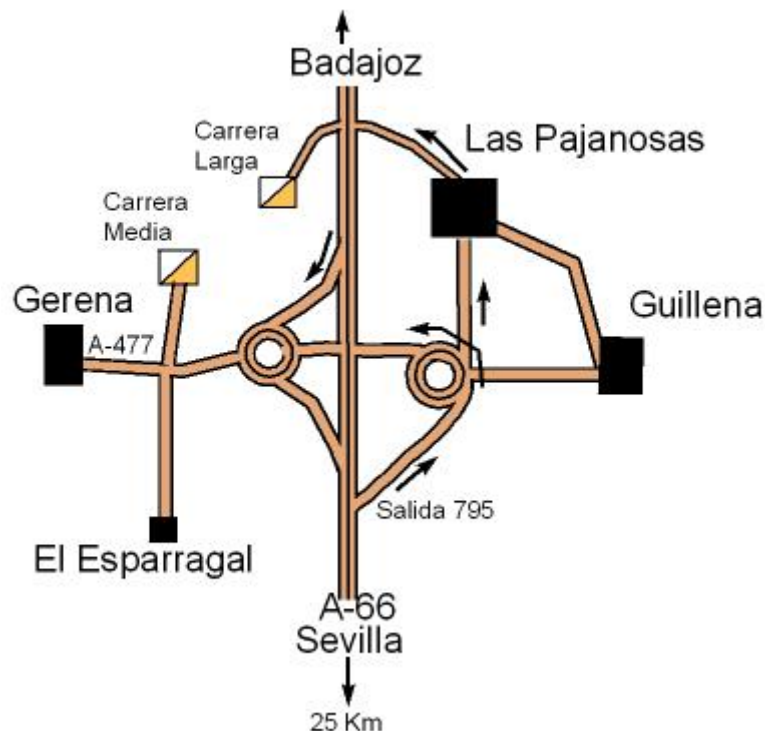
*World Ranking Event: Prizes for the 5 first runners of every category.
